**Intro: 16 :: \*Just 1 tag at end of wall 4 for 4 counts**

## **Lindy R, Rocking Chair, Lindy L, Rocking Chair**

1&2-3-4      Step R side, R/L/R rock back on L, step on R  
5-8            Step fwd. L, back on R, back on L return to R

1&2-3-4      Step L side L/R/L, rock back on R, step on L  
5-8            Step fwd. R, back on L, back on R, return to L

## **Jazz Box in Place, Jazz Box turning ¼ R**

1-4            Step R over L, step back on L, step on R, then L  
5-8            Step R over L, step back on L turning ¼ R, step on R, then L

## **K Step**

1-4            Step R diagonally fwd. touch L to R, Step L back diagonally, touch R to L  
5-8            Step R back diagonally, touch L to R, Step L fwd. diagonally, touch R to L

## **\*Tag: Side step R/L at end of wall 4**

1-4            Step R, touch L to R, Step L, touch R to L
