| 1 | Step left across right making ¼ turn right |
| 2-3 | Step right beside left, step left together |
| 4-6 | Step right to right side, step left behind right, step right beside left |
| 7-9 | Step left to left side, step right behind left, step left beside right |
| 10 | Step right across left making ¼ turn left |
| 11-12 | Step left beside right, step right together |
| | |
| 13-15 | Fan right foot, tap ball of right foot beside left twice |
| 16-18 | Repeat previous beats 13 to 15 |
| 19-21 | Step back on right making ½ turn left, step forward left, step right beside left |
| 22-24 | Waltz forward left-right-left |
| 25-36 | Repeat previous beats 13 to 24 |

| 37-39 | Step back on right, scuff & hitch left, slap left thigh with left hand |
| 40-42 | Step in place left-right-left |
| 43-48 | Repeat previous beats 37 to 42 |

| 49-51 | Waltz forward right-left-right |
| 52-54 | Step forward on left, scuff & hitch right, slap right thigh with right hand |
| 55-57 | Step in place right-left-right |
| 58-63 | Repeat previous beats 52 to 57 |
| The following steps are serpentine steps & are executed traveling backwards | |
| 64-66 | Step left behind right, step right beside left, step left together |
| 67-69 | Step right behind left, step left beside right, step right together |
| 70-75 | Repeat previous beats 64 to 69 |

| 76-78 | Place left foot behind right & unwind ½ turn left, hold |
| 79-81 | Waltz backwards right-left-right |
| 82-87 | Repeat previous beats 76 to 81 |
